## Economy Overview

**45,894**

**Population (2016)**

Population **grew by 81** over the last 5 years but is projected to **decrease by 34** over the next 5 years.

**22,914**

**Jobs (2016)**

Jobs **grew by 2,456** over the last 5 years and are projected to **grow by 1,239** over the next 5 years.

**Avg. Earnings Per Job (2016)**

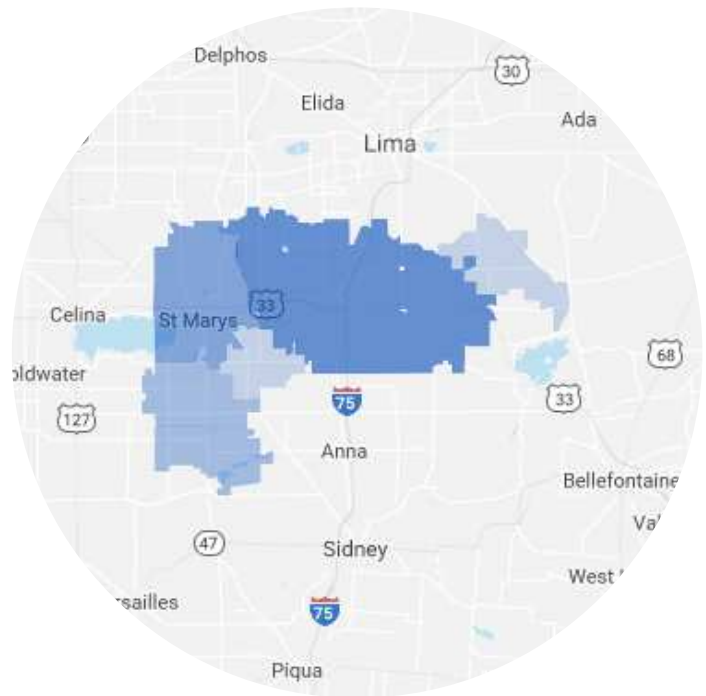
Regional average earnings per job are **\$12.4K below** the national average earnings of \$62.1K per job.

As of 2016 the region's population **increased by 0.2%** since 2011, growing by 81. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.1%** between 2016 and 2021, losing 34.

From 2011 to 2016, jobs **increased by 12.0%** in Auglaize County, OH from 20,458 to 22,914. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 8.8% by 3.2%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 65.8% to 65.5% between 2011 and 2016**.

Concerning educational attainment, **10.5% of Auglaize County, OH residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (7.8% below the national average), and **10.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.2% above the national average).

The top three industries in 2016 are Other General Purpose Machinery Manufacturing, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Motor Vehicle Parts Manufacturing.

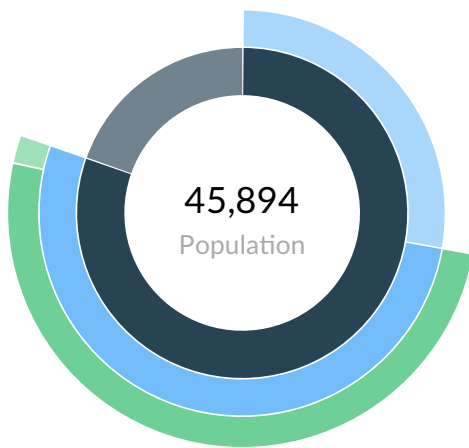

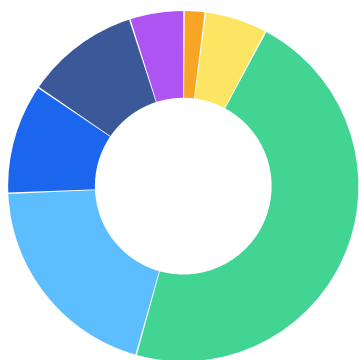

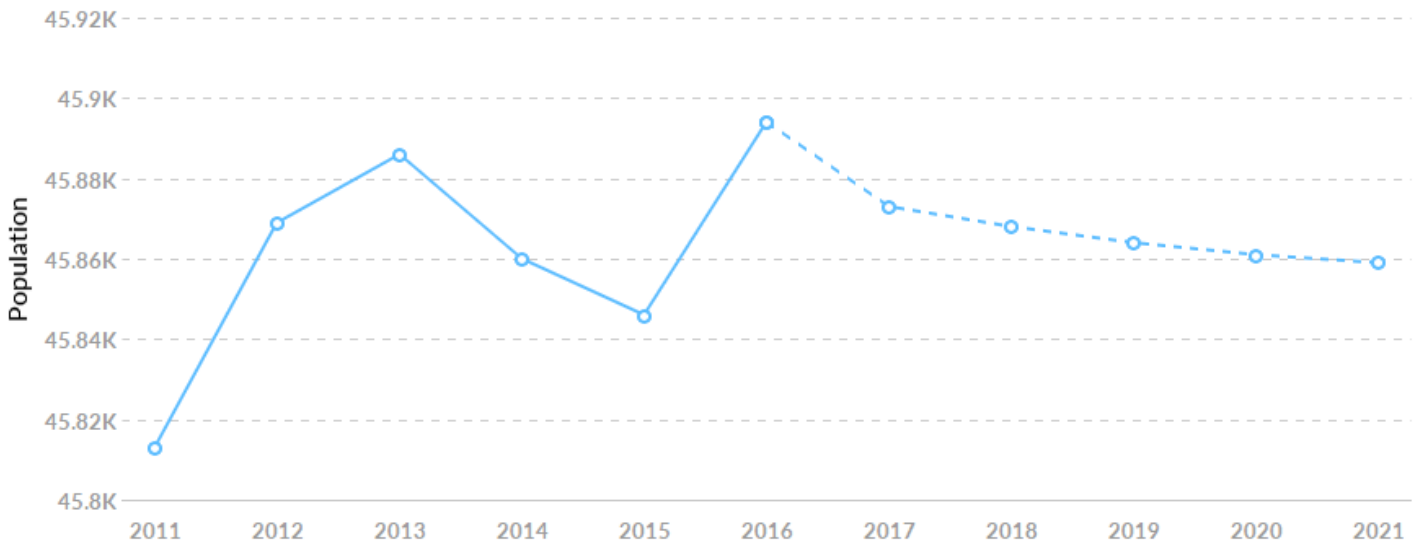

As of 2016 the region's population increased by 0.2% since 2011, growing by 81. Population is expected to decrease by 0.1% between 2016 and 2021, losing 34.

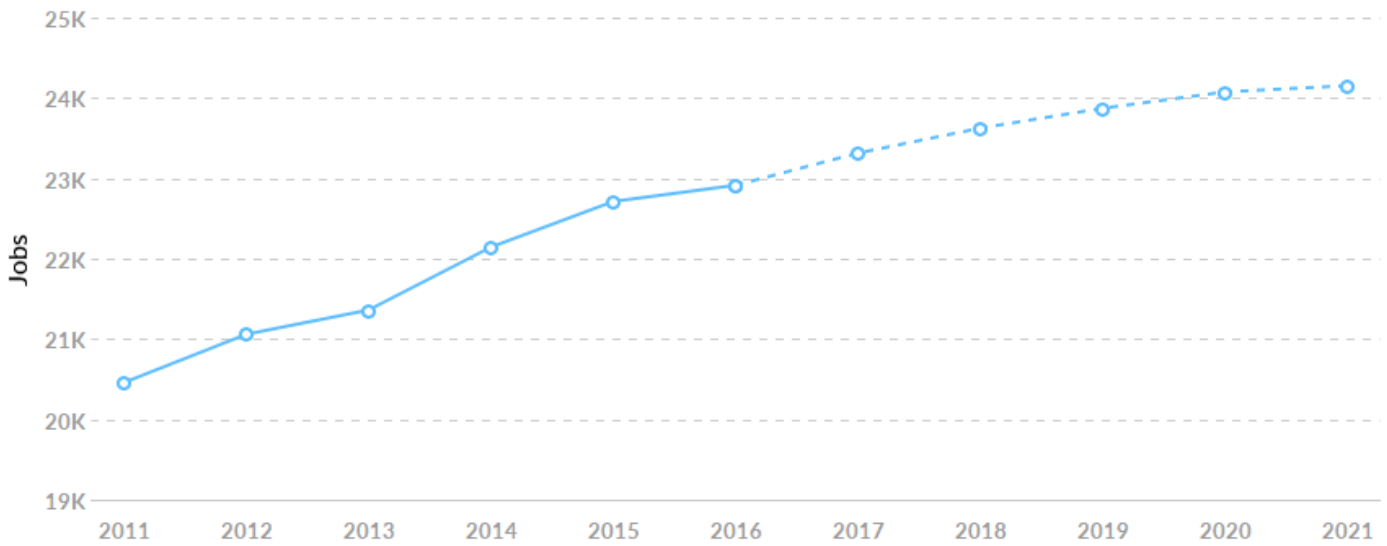

## Job Trends

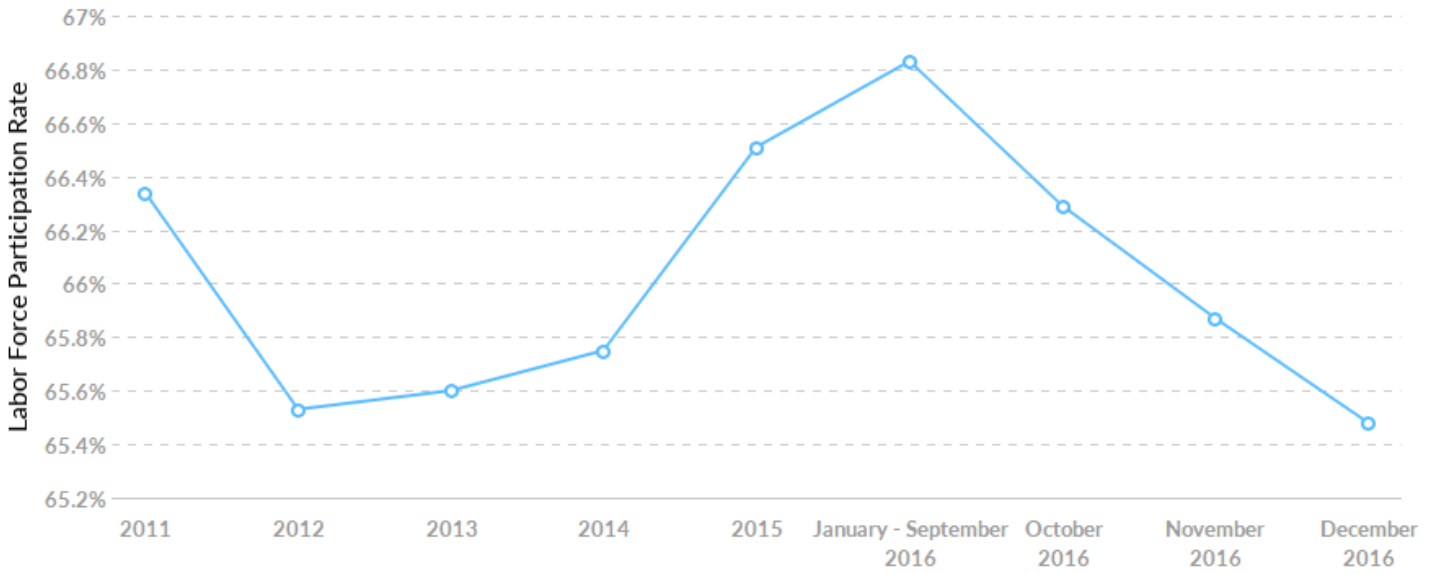

### Labor Force Participation Rate Trends



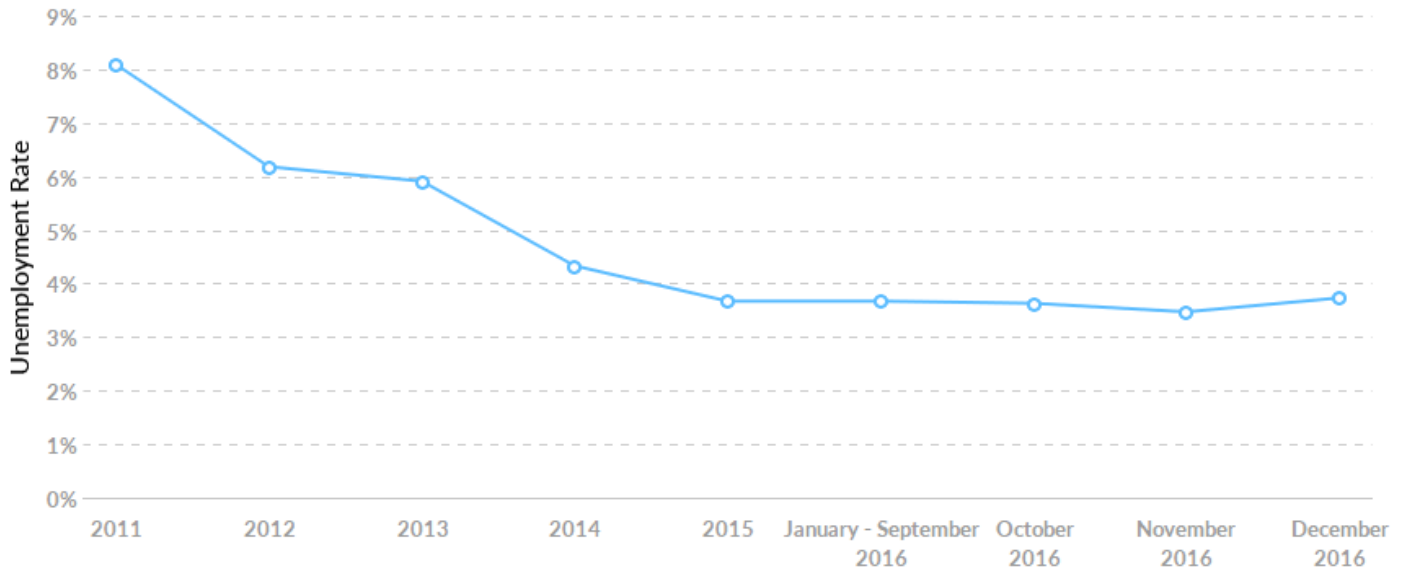

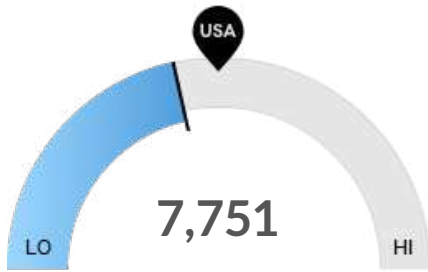
### Unemployment Rate Trends

Auglaize County, OH had a December 2016 unemployment rate of 3.73%, **decreasing from 8.09%** 5 years before.



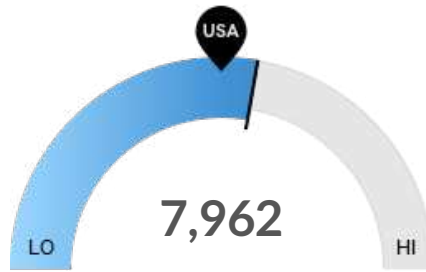

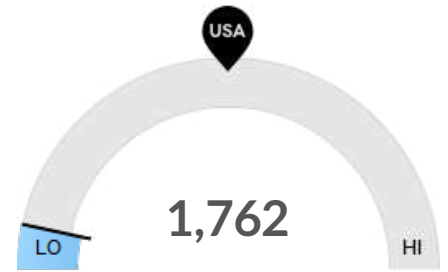
**Millennials**

Auglaize County, OH has 7,751 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 9,531.



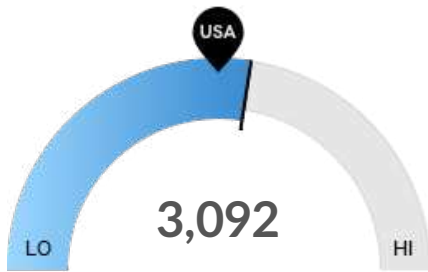
**Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Auglaize County, OH. The national average for an area this size is 6,820 people 65 or older, while there are 7,962 here.



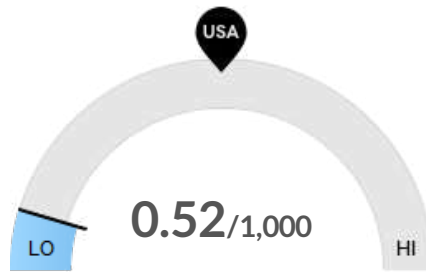
**Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is low in Auglaize County, OH. The national average for an area this size is 17,563 racially diverse people, while there are 1,762 here.



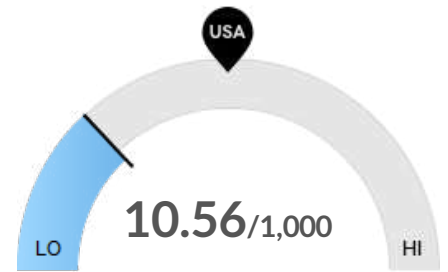
**Veterans**

Auglaize County, OH has 0.52 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.75 per 1,000 people.



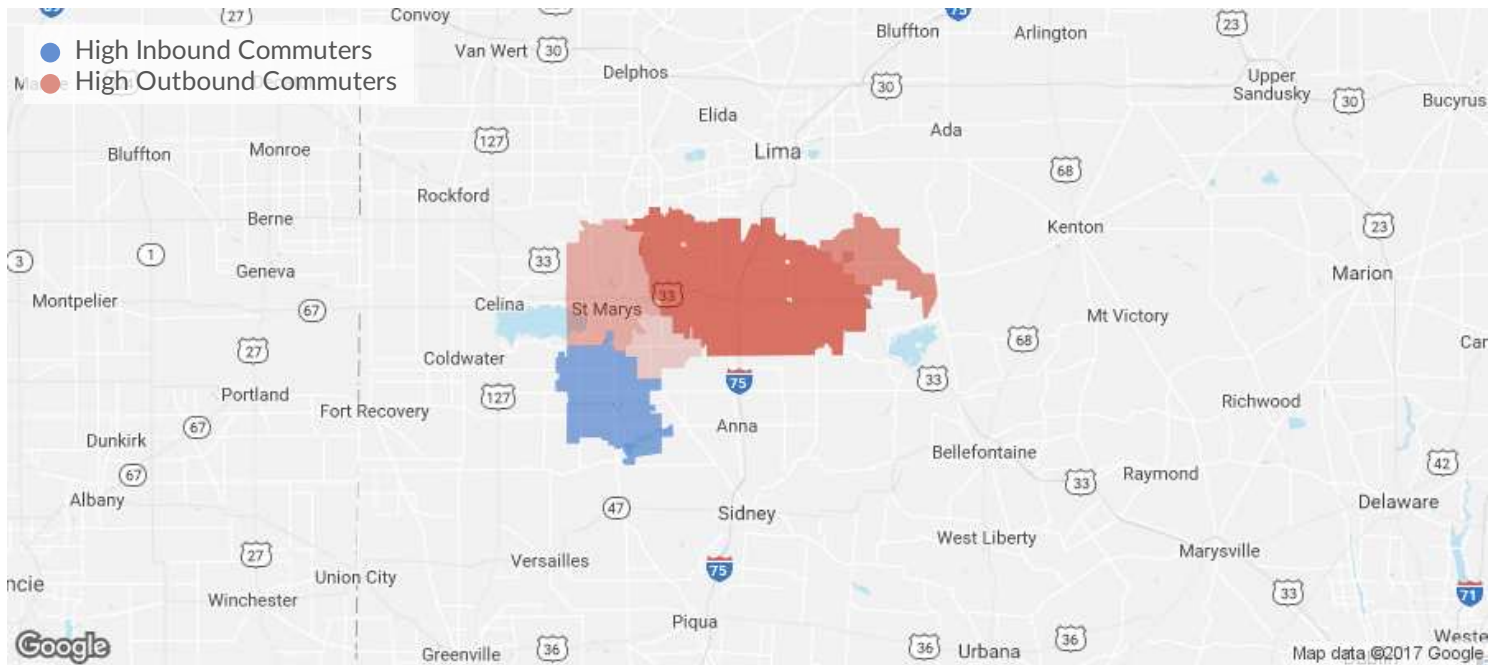
**Property Crime**

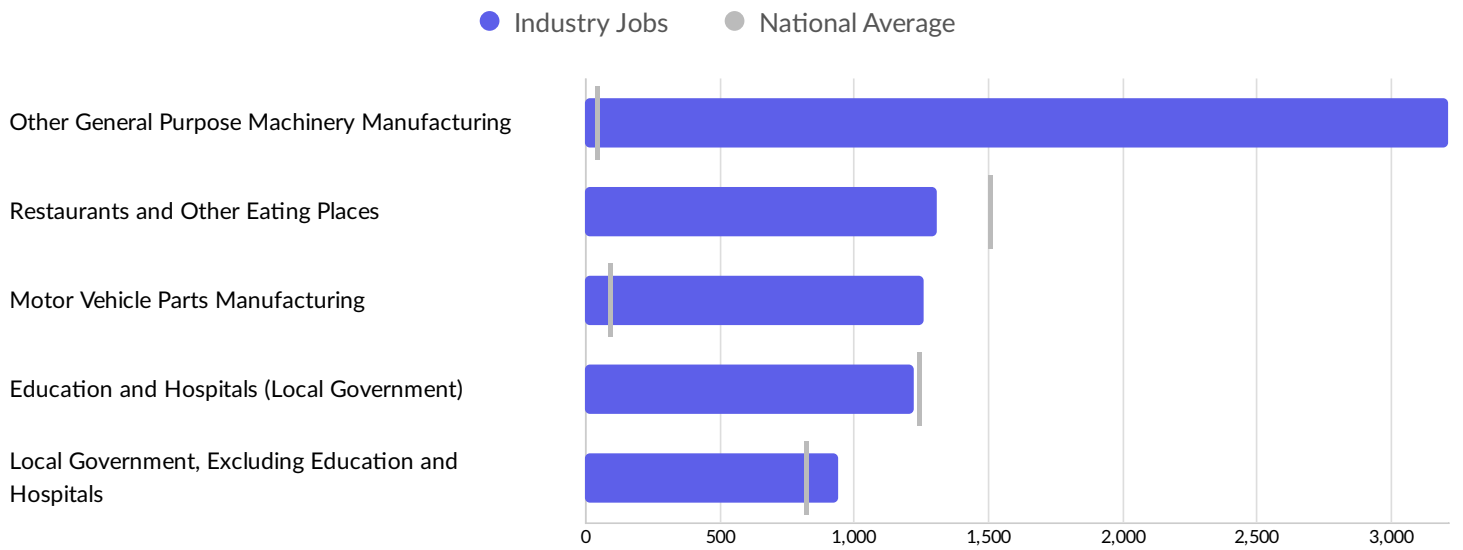

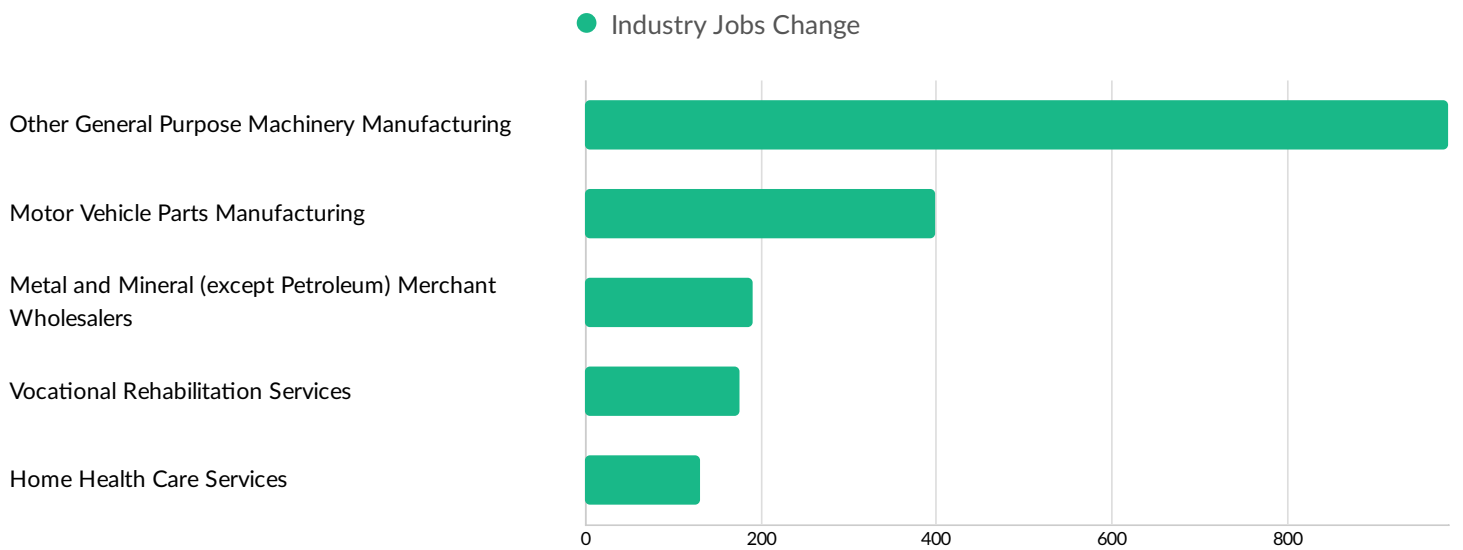

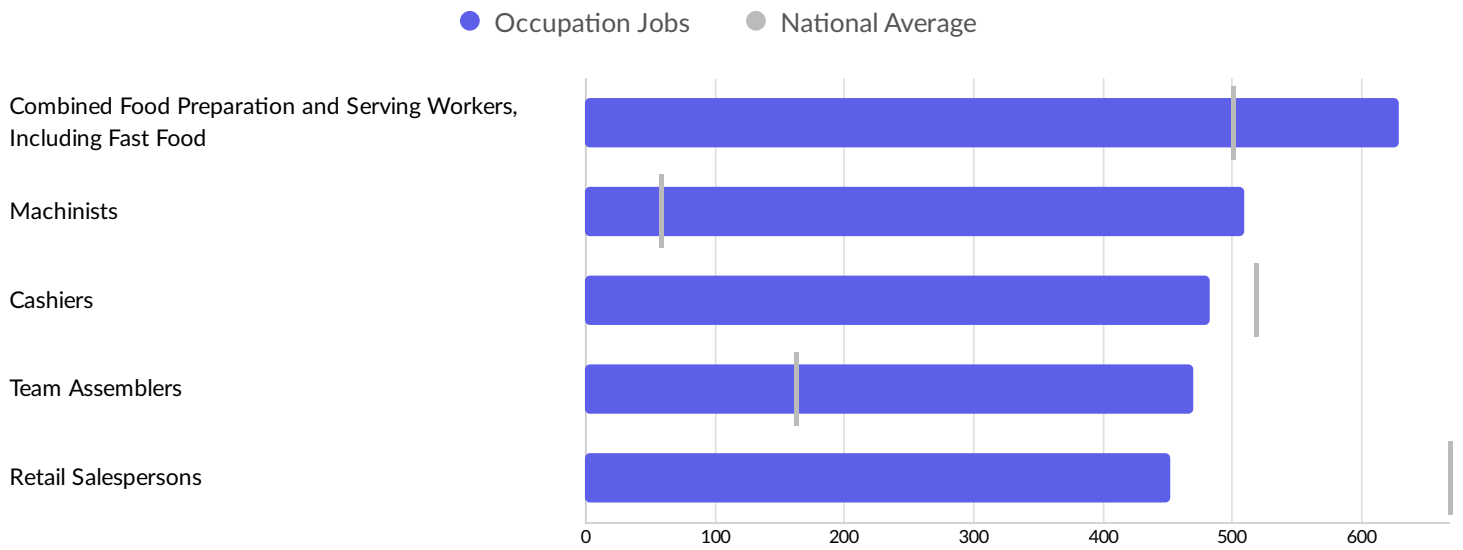

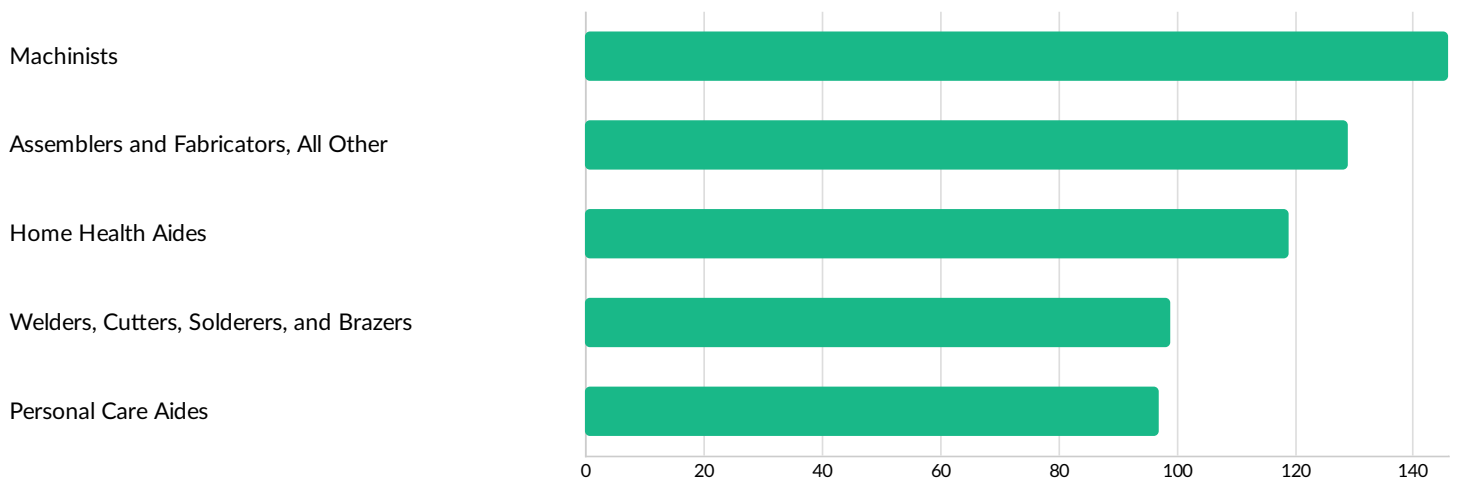
