
Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 2.1% since 2017, growing by 715. Population is expected to increase by 2.5% between 2022 and 2027, adding 875.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs increased by 2.4% in Putnam County, OH from 12,711 to 13,016. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 71.4% to 71.8% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.7% of Putnam County, OH residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.1% below the national average), and **14.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Motor Vehicle Parts Manufacturing, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.




Nov 2022 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity









Labor Force Participation Rate Trends




Putnam County, OH had a November 2022 unemployment rate of 2.18%, decreasing from 3.54% 5 years before.






Millennials




Veterans

Retirement risk is high in Putnam County, OH. The national average for an area this size is 10,201 people 55 or older, while there are 11,265 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Putnam County, OH. The national average for an area this size is 13,965 racially diverse people, while there are 2,869 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Location Quotient






Top Industry GRP




