Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 0.4% since 2019, growing by 72. Population is expected to decrease by 0.1% between 2024 and 2029, losing 16.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 3.0% in Paulding County, OH from 5,816 to 5,991. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 1.3%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 58.8% to 59.7% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.9% of Paulding County**, **OH residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.6% below the national average), and **10.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Animal Production, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.











As of 2024 the region's population increased by 0.4% since 2019, growing by 72. Population is expected to decrease by 0.1% between 2024 and 2029, losing 16.



Job Trends






Paulding County, OH had a June 2025 unemployment rate of 5.04%, decreasing from 7.42% 5 years before.



Millennials


Paulding County, OH has 3,146 millennials (ages 25-39). The size is 3,801.






Veterans

Paulding County, OH has 1,138 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 925.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Paulding County, OH. The national average for an area this size is 5,647 people 55 or older, while there are 6,375 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Paulding County, OH. The national average for an area this size is 7,791 racially diverse people, while there are 1,674 here.




Property Crime






Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP






Top Growing Occupations






Top Occupation Employment Concentration










